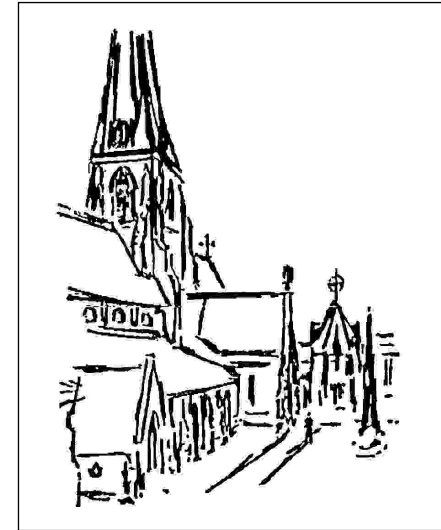
#### **COLLECT FOR THE WEEK**
