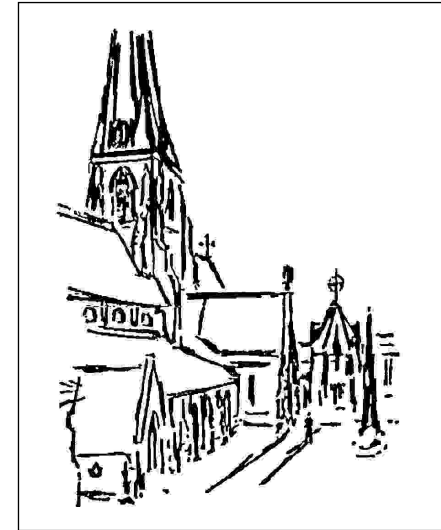
COLLECT FOR THE WEEK
