A **Special General Vestry** meeting to elect the Search Committee will take place Sunday, 14 June at 12 at noon.

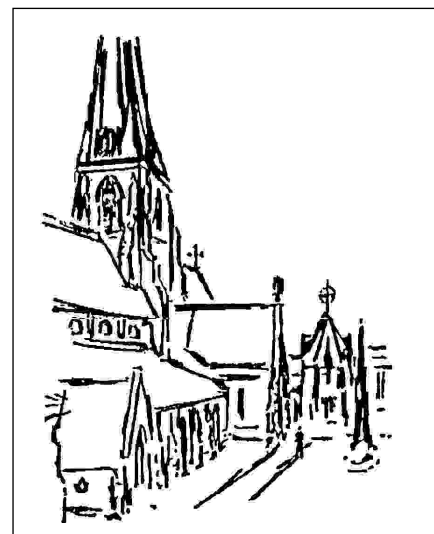
We are now actively collecting items for **our next Bazaar:** books, kitchenware, china, costume jewellery & boxes. For information please see Verna.
