2. What is your responsibility as members of the flock?
Psalm 95:6-7; Mathew 25:35-36
3. How can you be a modern day good shepherd according to the mystery of His Will?
Ezekiel 34:23; Ephesians 1:9-10; Mathew 25:40
4. Your questions for discussion relating to the texts and sermon.

Reflective Questions:

1. What is your most significant experience as a member of the 'Flock' of Christ?
2. How can you use your experience to Glorify God in building His Kingdom?
3. Personal experiences you want to share relating to the texts and sermon.
