The “modern” tithe for Canadian Anglicans is 5%.

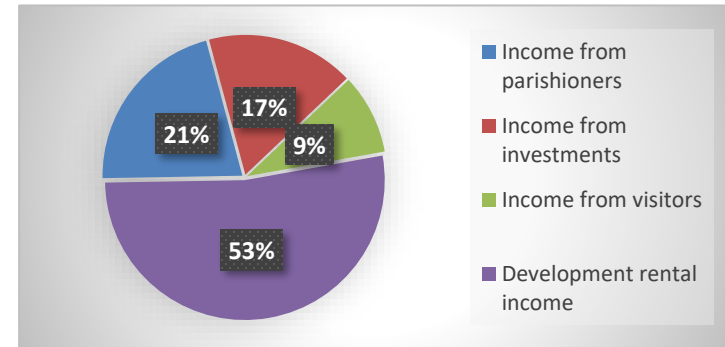

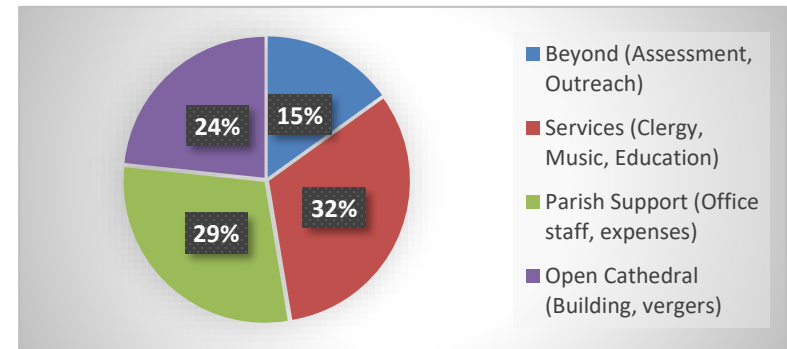
Our Income

The Cathedral is blessed with investment income and rent from the office tower and mall. Together, these represent 70% of our current income, budgeted at \$777,570 for 2018.



Our Expenses

For 2018, the congregation approved an operating budget of \$867,067 with a budgeted shortfall just under \$90,000. Congregational giving needs to grow in order to avoid deficit budgets!



It takes many skills to run the Cathedral

We are looking for volunteers in many areas including: leading prayers of the people during services; leading bible study; welcoming visitors in the cathedral; coordinating volunteers; finance; carpentry; low level maintenance; hospitality organising; cleaning; painting; document scanning; archives; displays; making posters; cathedral decoration; event organising; online calendar updating; producing weekly bulletins; IT support; website design and maintenance; social media strategy and management.

Some of these tasks can take as little as 30 mins a week, others might be a greater commitment.
