1 Kings 8, 22-30

SECOND LESSON / DEUXIÈME LECTURE

I Corinthians 3: 9-17

For we are God's servants, working together; you are God's field, God's building.

For no one can lay any foundation other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Jesus Christ.
