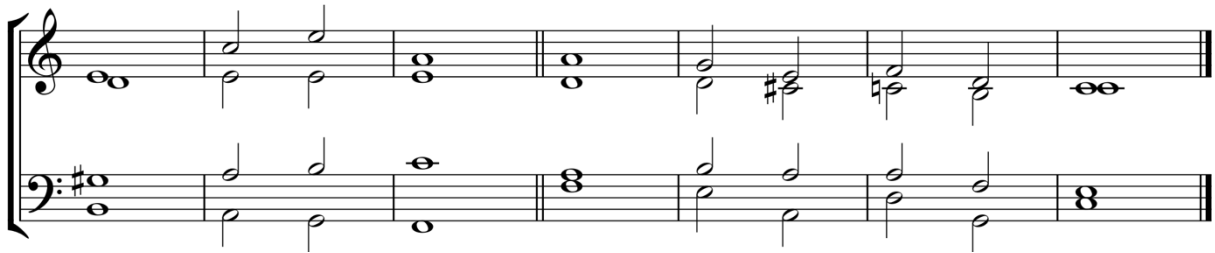
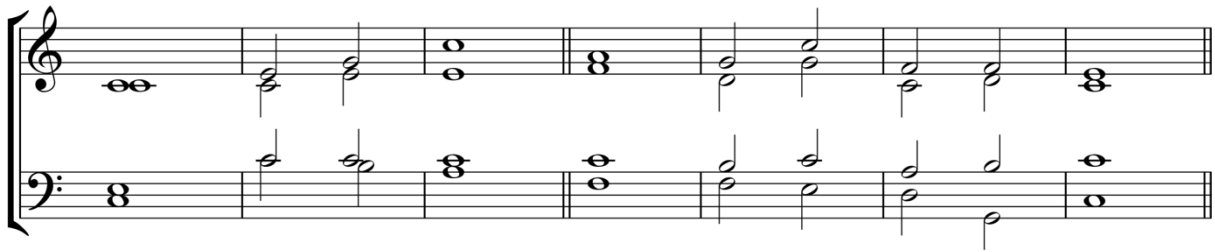


Deus, iudicium
